

Lavender class Geography Theme Home Learning – Location, Location, Location

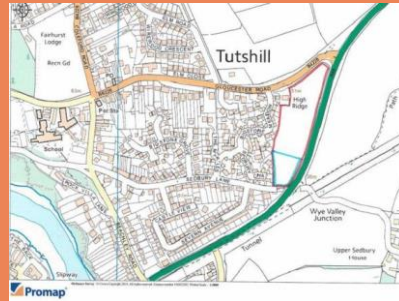

Research photographs of Sedbury/Chepstow and write how the area has changed.



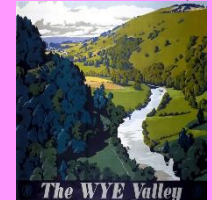
Design and make a copy off Chepstow Castle or the Seven Bridge and write a set of instructions for the process.
